

Lucky Lotto Frequently Asked Questions

- What if I can't sell the whole book?

Since you have prepaid for your tickets at registration it is the decision of each family as to how many tickets you want to sell, or you can keep all the tickets for your opportunity to win one of our cash prizes. For those families that choose to sell the tickets you will collect \$65.00 which you keep and equals the cost of the prepayment amount of each book.

- How do I sell the tickets?

Each book contains 40 spots to rub off & 50 tickets. The buyer of the ticket will rub a spot to determine the cost of their donation. They will pay that amount & receive their ticket. The tickets range from free to \$3.00. Once all the spots have been sold and scratched off you will have collected \$65.00 and 5 tickets will be left over. The 5 tickets that are left over are yours. - **They are free as a thank you for being part of Union City Little League**

- How many books does each player have to sell?

Each player is responsible for selling one book of tickets but no more than 2 books per family.

- What does Union City Little League do with all the money?

We spend over \$100,000. annually to run our program. That includes the cost of equipment, umpires, insurance, uniforms and more. This along with the revenue from our concessions all goes towards running a great youth league program. This year let's all get together to help make this an enjoyable, fun filled season for our kids.
